NOTES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries close on 15th March 2024 and will not be accepted on show day.

The Warkworth A & P Lifestyle Show accepts non stud animals BUT they must be purebred in their breed (to be listed)

1. All animals are to have a NAIT identification tag and movement is to be recorded at the Warkworth A & P Show Society Nait number 441964.
2. Animals may be stalled on Friday night prior to the show at the owner's responsibility. Please indicate this on your entry form so we can prepare (no extra charge).
3. The Warkworth A&P Show Society Committee reserves the right to alter, amend, amalgamate or cancel any class up to and until judging commences on show day.
4. Warkworth A&P Society has the right to substitute product made available by sponsors in any one class in lieu of cash prizes.
5. All cattle ages will be computed as at 1st June unless otherwise specified.

6. All bulls 15 months and over must be ringed.
7. Judge's decision is final.
8. Any protest may be lodged with the Warkworth A&P Show Office within one hour of the event accompanied by a \$50 cash fee.

Please note that the Beef Section are Interbreed classes this year.

THE SOCIETY'S POLICY DOES NOT COVER COMPETITORS AND EXHIBITORS

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and Health & Safety in Employment Act 1992. No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible are permitted in the marshalling area.

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING:

There are now two documents required,

T.B. Test document (appropriate for your area – i.e movement control) is to accompany the entry forms.

T.B. transit document must accompany the animal on show day.

For animals from herds which are under movement restrictions imposed by an Official Directive or Restricted Place Notice issued by the Animal Health Board – the following applies:

- a. That no cattle from a movement control herd be exhibited at A & P Shows.
- b. For animals from Declared Movement Control Areas:
- c. All Show animals over the age of 90 days are to be tested, and have a clear test, within 60 days prior to being moved to the show.

For animals from C10 status herds in Surveillance areas (e.g Northland) -

No test is required but a clearly dated test allocation form or other documentation from the Animal Health Board must be submitted that shows that the herd is not overdue for a whole herd test.

For animals from all other herds and areas - if the herd has a C3 status or better, no test is required PROVIDED the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show.

- d. If the whole herd test was not within 12 months of the show, then show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within the current show season.
- e. If the herd has a status of 1 or C2, THEN show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within the current Show season
- f. MYCOPLASMA BOVIS PLEASE SEE THE ATTACHED MPI M.bovis GUIDELINES FOR CATTLE EXHIBITORS. BRING YOUR OWN WATER TROUGHS AND STAY APART FROM OTHER COMPETITORS/CATTLE

3. All cattle must tie up and be led for judging.
