**ALL INDOOR EXHIBITS WILL BE DISPLAYED AND JUDGED ON FRIDAY 15th MARCH 2024.**

**Entries will be accepted from 8.30am until 11.30am on Friday 15th March 2024, or Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> of March at the Show Office from 6:00 to 7:30pm.**

Please have your entry forms completed prior to arrival. If you require assistance please complete as much as you can and ask for assistance when you arrive.

Exhibits must be accompanied by fees when handed in.

## **ENTRY FEES:**

- Senior \$1.00
- Junior 20 cents

Only judges and stewards are permitted in the marquee during judging time.

The Indoor Section of the Marquee will be closed to the public at 3.00pm on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Removal of exhibits from 3.00pm to 4.00pm under the guidance of the stewards.

Any exhibits not removed by this time without communication with the stewards will be donated to Hospice. (The removal of exhibits must be strictly adhered to for security reasons.)

## **FIELD & GARDEN PRODUCE SECTION**

PRODUCE MUST BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR

- Class 1 Four Potatoes, any variety
- Class 2 Collection of fresh herbs - minimum 4 varieties
- Class 3 Two onions
- Class 4 One vegetable marrow or courgette
- Class 5 One buttercup pumpkin
- Class 6 Two beetroot
- Class 7 Two pods of dwarf beans
- Class 8 Two pods climbing beans
- Class 9 Two sticks of rhubarb
- Class 10 Two apple cucumbers
- Class 11 Two long cucumbers
- Class 12 Two stalks of Silverbeet - *may be put in a jar of water to prevent wilting*
- Class 13 Two stalks of spinach - *may be put in a jar of water to prevent wilting*
- Class 14 Two tomatoes
- Class 15 Three kinds salad vegs, one of each
- Class 16 A collection of produce - *may be fruit or vegs or a mixed display*
- Class 17 Biggest Pumpkin
- Class 18 Three eggs - single yolk, judged by weight
- Class 19 Any produce not listed above

## **PRESERVES SECTION**

WILL BE OPENED FOR TASTING

- Class 20 Any choice of jelly
- Class 21 Marmalade
- Class 22 One jar of any stone fruit jam eg. plum, peach
- Class 23 Any other variety of jam
- Class 24 Lemon or lime honey, lemon or lime cheese
- Class 25 A collection of 3 varieties, jams, jellies etc.
- Class 26 A jar of fancy pickles, fruits or herb vinegar
- Class 27 Pickle - any variety
- Class 28 Relish - any variety

- Class 40 Fruit Cake, no icing (using dried fruit)
- Class 41 A decorated cake - JUDGED ON DECORATION ONLY
- Class 42 Fresh Fruit/Veg Cake - ie carrot, banana
- Class 43 Fruit Loaf
- Class 44 Three Scones, any type
- Class 45 Three Muffins
- Class 46 Three Shortbread
- Class 47 Three decorated Cup cakes
- Class 48 Three Biscuits, any type
- Class 49 Afternoon Tea Plate, 2 pieces of any 3 varieties
- Class 50 Three pieces of uncooked Slice
- Class 51 Three pieces of Cooked Slice
- Class 52 A Fruit Tart/Pie

## FLOWER SECTION

FLOWERS MUST BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR AND DISPLAYED IN THE BOTTLES PROVIDED  
PRESENTATION IS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION

- Class 58 A potted succulent
- Class 59 Three kinds of cut flowers, one stem or spray of each
- Class 60 Three kinds of dahlias, distinct varieties.
- Class 61 Specimen Dahlia Bloom
- Class 62 Specimen Rose Bloom
- Class 63 Specimen Rose - old fashioned variety
- Class 64 Three stems of any one variety, NOT DAHLIAS
- Class 65 Three stems of marigolds, African or French
- Class 66 A container of pelargoniums and/or geraniums
- Class 67 Single Specimen bloom, not roses or dahlias
- Class 68 Specimen spray or cluster
- Class 69 Potted Foliage Plant - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*
- Class 70 Potted flowering Plant - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*
- Class 71 African violet - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*
- Class 72 Three kinds of foliage
- Class 73 Bromeliad - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*
- Class 74 Succulent or Cacti - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*
- Class 75 Bonsai - *must be owned by the exhibitor for at least three months*

## FLORAL ART SECTION

FLOWERS NEED NOT BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR

- Class 76 Open Design - do your own thing
- Class 77 "Summer Time"

*An arrangement from the beach. Must have at least 50% flora/foilage contents*

## NEEDLEWORK SECTION

ALL WORK TO BE DONE BY THE EXHIBITOR. NO PROFESSIONAL WORK ACCEPTED.

- Class 78 Any embroidered or tapestry article - mounted or unmounted
- Class 79 DELETED CLASS
- Class 80 Dressed doll, sewn clothes
- Class 81 Machine made garment
- Class 82 Patchwork or quilted article
- Class 83 Sewn soft toy
- Class 84 Upcycled Garment - include photos of original garment/s - *A garment made from part of or multiple garments. Must be at least 50% from at least one other garment*

## FIBRE CRAFT SECTION

- Class 85 Any item of Knitting (not included in Classes 86-90)
- Class 86 Hand Spun Item (yarn must be spun by entrant)
- Class 87 A Knitted Article with Embellishments, eg. feathers, etc
- Class 88 Knitwear for children up to 10 years of age
- Class 89 Any Handwoven Item (must be created by entrant)
- Class 90 Classic Baby - Booties, Bonnets or helmets and or jackets

## CRAFT SECTION

- Class 91 A hand crafted card or scrap book page
- Class 92 Art work - may include mixed media
- Class 93 A piece of Jewellery ie. beadwork
- Class 94 Woodworked Article
- Class 95 Cushion cover- any medium
- Class 96 A Christmas Decoration
- Class 97 A decorated hat or fascinator
- Class 98 Upcycle - rework an old object into a new something else (non garment), include photos of original object/item
- Class 99 Any Craft article not mentioned

The Indoor Section of the Marquee will be closed to the public at 3.00pm on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Removal of exhibits from 3.00pm to 4.00pm must be under the guidance of the Stewards.

- Class 108 A piece of digital artwork ie. CD cover or card
- Class 109 A photo any subject - unmounted -No digital changes accepted.- any size
- Class 110 Woodwork

## INTERMEDIATE SECTION - 9-13 years
